QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

PROFFESOR - GRADE 15 (Job Ref: UoEm/Law/Prof./01/2019)

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in law or its equivalent from a recognized University. In addition, applicants must:

- i. Have at least twelve (12) years of University teaching experience, three (3) of which as full time Associate Professor;
- ii. Have at least sixty (60) publication points, forty (40) of which are from articles in referred scholarly journals since being appointed Associate Professor;
- iii. Have successfully supervised to completion at least six (6) Masters and two (2) PhD students since being appointed Associate Professor;
- iv. Show evidence of successfully securing at least two (2) research grants since being appointed Associate Professor;
- v. Show evidence of attendance and contribution of learned conferences, seminars or workshops;
- vi. Show evidence of active participation/leadership in departmental and University activities; and
- vii. Show evidence of continued research.

ASSOCIATE PROFFESOR – GRADE 14 (Job Ref: UoEm/Law/Ass. Prof./01/2019)

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in law or its equivalent from a recognized University. In addition, applicants must:



- i. Have at least eight (8) years of University teaching experience, three (3) of which as full time Senior Lecturer;
- ii. Have at least 48 publication points, 32 of which are from articles in refereed scholarly journals since being appointed Senior Lecturer;
- iii. Have successfully supervised to completion at least five (5) Masters and one (1) PhD student since being appointed Senior Lecturer;
- iv. Show evidence of successfully securing at least two (2) research grants since being appointed Senior Lecturer;
- v. Show evidence of attendance and contribution at learned conferences, seminars or workshops;
- vi. Show evidence of active participation/leadership in departmental and University activities; and vii. Show evidence of continued research.

SENIOR LECTURER - GRADE 13 (Job Ref: UoEm/Law/S-Lec./01/2019)

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in law or its equivalent from a recognized University. In addition, applicants must

- i. Have at least five (5) years of University teaching experience, three (3) of which as full time Lecturer;
- ii. Have at least 32 publication points, 24 of which are from articles in refereed scholarly journals since being appointed Lecturer;
- iii. Have successfully supervised to completion at least four (4) Masters students since being appointed Lecturer;
- iv. Show evidence of successfully securing at least one (1) research grant since being appointed Lecturer;
- v. Show evidence of attendance and contribution at learned conferences, seminars or workshops;
- vi. Show evidence of active participation/leadership in departmental and University activities; and
- vii. Show evidence of continued research;

LECTURER – GRADE 12 (Job Ref: UoEm/Law/Lect./01/2019)

Applicants must be holders of an earned PhD degree in law or its equivalent from a recognized University. In addition, applicants must:

- i. Have a Master's degree in addition to a first degree from a recognized University in the relevant field;
- ii. Show evidence of attendance and contribution at learned conferences, seminars or workshops; and iii. Show evidence of continued research.

Those who have university teaching experience and have published in refereed journals will have an added advantage.



Applicants with Master of Laws (LL.M.) degree or its equivalent who have at least three (3) years University teaching experience and have at least 24 publication points, 16 of which are from articles in refereed scholarly journals, or;

Applicants with a Master of Laws degree or its equivalent who have registered for a PhD and made substantive progress will also be considered

TUTORIAL FELLOW – GRADE 11 (Job Ref: UoEm/Law/TF/01/2019)

Applicants must be holders of a Bachelors degree in law or its equivalent of at least second class upper division and a Master's degree in law or its equivalent from a recognized university. In addition, the applicants must be registered for a PhD Degree.

How to apply

1. Open the University of Embu website; www.embuni.ac.ke, choose the job application portal and fill in your details as guided; and
2. Send one (1) hard copy of the application letter, accompanied by detailed curriculum vitae (signed on all pages), copies of certified academic and professional certificates, National ID card, current pay slip (if any) and other relevant testimonials. Provide your mobile numbers, email address and names of three (3) referees (who should send their recommendation letters directly to the undersigned in sealed envelope).

Note: Applicants who do not submit one (1) hard copy of the application package will not be considered.

In addition, applicants must also submit the clearance certificate from the following;

- i. Kenya Revenue Authority;
- ii. Higher Education Loans Board (showing status of loan recovery);
- iii. Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission;
- iv. Credit Reference Bureau; and
- v. Certificate of Good Conduct from Directorate of Criminal Investigation.

An application package together with referee letters (with job reference number clearly marked on the envelope) should reach the undersigned not later than 20th February, 2019.
