The minimum admission requirements to the Bachelor of Laws programme are a **Mean Grade of C+ (Plus)** at KCSE or its equivalent with at least a **B (Plain)** in **English** or **Kiswahili**. Application forms can either be obtained from the **Admissions Office, University of Embu**, or **downloaded** from the University website at **www.embuni.ac.ke** and should be submitted upon payment of a **non-refundable application fee** of **KSh. 2,000** for **East Africans** and **USD 50** for **Non-East Africans**.
