Through this new Strategic Plan, we hope to see major transformations in the University with the key objectives of re-affirming our commitment to our mission and purpose while undertaking significant and bold steps to enhance our image and our students' and staff experience as we forge ahead for the next 10 years.

On ISO certification, I must say that I am also very happy with the way we have worked together, united as a family bound together by our collective determination to ensure that our customers get the best quality and highest standards of service.

The Journey to re-certification to ISO 9001:2015, Quality Management System (QMS) and certification to ISO 27001:2013, Information Security Management Systems (ISMS) began in May 2017 and one year later on 28th June 2018, the University of Embu became not only the first University but also the first education Institution in Kenya to attain ISO 27001:2013 Certification. This landmark achievement was also coupled with the recertification to ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management Systems by transiting from ISO 9001:2008.



The certification and recertification reaffirms the University's commitment to ensuring that our processes adhere to the requirements of the standards for information confidentiality, integrity, security, accuracy and availability. It is also an indication of the University's unrelenting commitment to adopting best practices and processes for quality management and customer satisfaction.

As I conclude, once again I want to thank all those who made these achievements possible for your contribution. The achievements have indeed transformed the University's landscape and elevated our rank higher above our peers.

I also thank the Community, the Government, through the Ministry of Education and all our well-wishers for the support that you have given us along the journey.
