Preamble

Despite being the cornerstone for the quality of education, Teacher Education (TE) faces challenges due to the shift from traditional knowledgebased teaching to a competency-based approach.

The process of reimagining teacher education is complex since it requires a multisectoral approach with a leadership that drives the change, and a concerted drive to change the mindset among the stakeholders

This conference, under the theme "Re-Imagining Teacher Education for Sustainable Development in Africa" targets education scholars and researchers, policymakers, and practitioners to explore transformative and practical strategies that equip educators with the competencies necessary to achieving Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG4).

It will be an opportunity to examine how teacher education reforms can be aligned with the UNESCO International Commission on the Futures of Education (UNESCO, 2021), which highlights the crucial role of teachers not only in providing quality instruction but also in shaping the critical, transversal skills that are necessary for our futures.

The Conference aims to develop actionable recommendations to inform teacher education reforms, increase collaboration between universities and education stakeholders in addressing the challenges of teacher education, and enhance understanding of the evolving roles of teachers and teacher education in a rapidly changing world.
