ANNOUNCEMENT FOR INTERNALLY FUNDED SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Embu (UoEm) invites applications for scholarships from suitably qualified persons to Masters Programmes in the following Schools:

- 1. School of Agriculture
- 2. School of Pure and Applied Sciences
- 3. School of Business and Economics
- 4. School of Education and Social Sciences
- 5. School of Nursing
- 6. School of Law

The scholarship package will cover tuition fees and stipend for the duration of study. The scholarships are open to all UoEm graduates. Programmes of study funded by the scholarship are scheduled to commence in January, 2026.

Important information

- 1) Applicants **MUST** be UoEm graduates
- 2) The scholarships are open to all UoEm graduates
- 3) Applicants must have obtained a minimum of Second Class Honors (Upper Division) in a relevant degree from the University of Embu. Applicants with Second Class Honours (Lower Division) and two years of relevant experience will also be considered.
- 4) The first part of the application should be completed online through the link, *Internally funded scholarships*, which is available on the University website www.embuni.ac.ke. Applications should reach the Registrar (Academics, Research and Extension) on or before 20th November, 2025.
- 5) After completing the first part of the application given in (4) above, applicants are required to undertake a Psychometric test. The test will be available on **24**th **November, 2025 from 9:00 to 10:00 am EAT.** The link to the test will be emailed to applicants who successfully complete the first part of the application.
