- Early Career Researchers (typically within 0–7 years of completing their PhD or at an equivalent stage of research development)
- Affiliated with a Kenyan university or research institution
- Working in the Humanities or Social Sciences

We strongly encourage applications from women, scholars in under-resourced institutions, and researchers facing structural barriers, including those with caregiving responsibilities.
